To extend the reach and diversity of its annual meetings, APS has developed a pilot program of APS Satellite Meetings. In 2022, these satellite meetings were held in Africa and Asia. In 2023, the satellite meetings were held in Sao Paulo, Brazil. In 2024, the satellite meeting will be held at NCP, Islamabad, Pakistan.
